Dear Mr. Woeck:

On March 26, 2014, we received your Year 3 monitoring report and on March 31, 2016, we received your Year 5 monitoring report for the Lake Sammamish State Park and Tributary B mitigation sites. These reports are for the mitigation work associated with the above-referenced permit for work in wetlands, West Fork Tibbetts Creek, Tibbetts Creek, Clay Pit Creek, five unnamed tributaries to Tibbetts Creek, and two unnamed tributaries to Issaquah Creek at the City of Issaquah and King County, Washington. We have reviewed the monitoring reports and have determined that they meet the requirements of special condition "e" of your permit and fulfill the requirements of your permit for the Tributary B mitigation site. While you do not need to submit any additional monitoring reports for the Tributary B mitigation site, please be reminded that the mitigation areas must be maintained in perpetuity as long as the permitted fill remains in place. Thank you for your compliance.

Please be reminded that in accordance with Special Condition "e" of your permit, your Year 7 monitoring report for the Lake Sammamish State Park mitigation site is due by April 1, 2018. Thank you for your continued cooperation in complying with the terms and conditions of your permit.
